Applications to Sit for the Aptitude Test for BAHons (Translation Studies) (English/Sinhala)

Applications are invited for the above aptitude test which is to be held on the **7th April, 2018** at the **Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka**, from the candidates who possess the minimum requirements for university admission as specified under section 2.2.8.28 of the Hand Book on 'Admission to Undergraduate Courses of the Universities in Sri Lanka for Academic Year 2017/2018' issued by the University Grants Commission.

Applicants, who submitted applications to the University Grants Commission to be considered for admission to the above Degree programme conducted by the Department of Languages, Faculty of Social Sciences and Languages, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, are required to apply, sit, and pass the aptitude test mentioned herein, if they wish to be considered for admission to the respective course.

The Department of Languages, Faculty of Social Sciences and Languages, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka introduces the study programme which offers candidates the opportunity of graduating with the BAHons (Translation Studies) (English/Sinhala). This is a four-year professional degree introduced as part of the overall strategic initiative to cater to the national needs of Sri Lanka.

Throughout the programme, priority will be given to implement the National Tri-Lingual Policy. The purpose of this degree programme is to equip the undergraduates with both theoretical and practical knowledge on Translation.

The applicants who have sat for the G.C.E (A/L) examination in 2017 in any of the subject streams are eligible to sit for the abovementioned aptitude test. The purpose of the aptitude test is to select a group of students with language (Sinhala and English) proficiency to conduct the four - year degree programme effectively and successfully.

Applications for the aptitude test can be downloaded from the university website www.sab.ac.lk. Each completed application should accompany a paying-in-voucher (obtained from the university website) for Rs. 500/- drawn in favour of the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, Account No. 0002246976 - Bank of Ceylon, (**Cheques & Postal / Money Orders will not be accepted**) along with copy of G.C.E. (A/L) certificate as applicable and a certificate indicating the result of the Common General Paper, **certified by the Principal of the School or a Justice of the Peace**. The official stamp of the certifying officer should be placed on each certified copy (**Original Certificates should not be sent**). Candidates are required to send a self-addressed envelope 10 ½ x 22 ½ cm in size without stamps along with the application which will be used to post the admission card for the Aptitude Test.

Duly completed application along with the copies of relevant certificates should be sent under the Registered Post, to reach the Senior Assistant Registrar, Academic & Student Affairs, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, P.O. Box 02, Belihuloya on or before **16th February 2018**. Mark '**BAHons (Translation Studies) (English/Sinhala)**' on the top left-hand corner of the envelope.

Any incomplete applications will be rejected without prior notice.
