






### NR Webinar

# **Cyber Risk Management**

An online workshop on "Blockchain-based Secure Framework for Supply Chain Management" was held on 22<sup>nd</sup> January 2024, in parallel with the 04th International Conference on Advanced Research in Computing. Using supply chain management as a case study, the workshop aimed to provide participants with a comprehensive understanding of blockchain technology and its application in designing and implementing cybersecurity frameworks and strategies. # **Expedition to Japan**




Silver Portal: Episode 10 – "Expedition to Japan" was held on 09<sup>th</sup> February 2024 via Zoom. The session explored Japan's values,

# **Environment and Japanese Culture**






### **Student Circle AGM**






# **Best Sportsmanship**
