The Year I, Year II, Year III and Year IV Semester I Examinations for the above batches of the Faculty of Social Sciences and Languages for the Academic Year 2022/2023 will be held in December 2024 onwards. Students of the above Faculty are accordingly advised to submit their applications as per instructions given below.

01. ISSUE OF APPLICATION FORMS

Applications should be submitted in prescribed forms obtainable from the Dean's Office of the Faculty of Social Sciences and Languages. Application Forms will be issued on **23rd, 24th and 25th October 2024** between 9.00 a.m. to 11.30 a.m. and from 1.30 p.m. to 3.30 p.m. at the Faculty.

Year I Semester I Examination application forms can be downloaded from the University Website (<https://www.sab.ac.lk/notices>).

02. SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED APPLICATION FORMS

Students should hand over their duly filled application forms to the Examination Branch on or before **28th October 2024**.

Year I Semester I Examination application forms should be posted to reach the "Senior Assistant Registrar, Examinations Branch, Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka, Belihuloya" on or before **01st November 2024**.

03. LATE APPLICATIONS

Late applications will be accepted only up to **30th October 2024** on payment of a late application fee of Rs. 15.00 per day. Under any circumstances no applications will be accepted thereafter.

04. FILLING IN THE APPLICATION FORMS

It is the responsibility of the candidates to enter all subjects (Title of Question Papers with Code Numbers) clearly in the application form. Heads of Departments may be consulted with regard to any clarification in completing the application forms.

05. APPLICATIONS FROM THE STUDENTS WHO HAVE FAILED OR HAVE NOT COMPLETED THEIR PREVIOUS EXAMINATIONS

Those students who fall into the above category are required to pay the appropriate examination fees along with their applications. The fees can be paid at any branch of the Bank of Ceylon to the credit of the Sabaragamuwa University, Account Number **0002246976** at Bank of Ceylon, Balangoda Branch, or direct to the Shroff of the University. Receipts for payment of fees should be attached to the applications.

FEE PAYABLE BY CANDIDATES REPEATING THE SEMESTER EXAMINATION
