If you or anyone you know has been a victim of harassment, misconduct, or distress, please be assured that the University provides comprehensive, confidential support mechanisms to assist you.

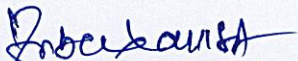
If you face an immediate safety threat, harassment, or intimidation on campus or within halls of residence:

Any act of retaliation, threat, or intimidation against a student seeking assistance or reporting an incident will be met with severe disciplinary and legal consequences.

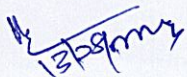
