

AI Policy for Extended Abstract Submission

**3rd International Conference on Social Sciences and Languages, Sabaragamuwa
University of Sri Lanka- 2026 December**

1. Aim & acceptable use of AI

This policy certifies academic integrity, originality, and transparency in all extended abstract submissions while allowing the responsible use of Artificial Intelligence (AI) tools. Authors may use AI tools only for supportive purposes, such as:

- Improving language, grammar, and readability
- Formatting and structuring the document
- Generating general ideas or outlines

AI should not replace the author's intellectual contribution

2. Disclosure Requirement

If AI tools are used at any stage of manuscript preparation, authors must clearly acknowledge this in their submission. A sample statement is provided below:

“The authors used AI tools for language editing and clarity. All ideas, analysis, and conclusions are the authors' own.”

Failure to disclose AI use may result in rejection of the submission.

3. Screening and Compliance

All submissions may be evaluated using plagiarism detection tools and other review methods. The conference committee reserves the right to:

- Reject submissions that violate this policy
- Request revisions or clarifications
- Withdraw accepted abstracts if misconduct is identified

4. Declaration

By submitting an extended abstract, authors confirm that:

- The work is original
- AI usage, if any, has been properly disclosed
- The submission complies with this policy
