YEAR IV SEMESTER II (2020/2021 BATCH) PROPER EXAMINATION

Year IV Semester II (2020/2021 Batch) Proper Examination of the Department of FST of the Faculty of Applied Sciences will be held in August 2026. It is compulsory for students to sit for the prescribed examinations for the **relevant semester** and the students are accordingly advised to submit their applications as per instructions given below.

01. ISSUE OF APPLICATION FORMS

Applications should be submitted on prescribed forms downloadable from the University Website. Forms will be available from **14th July 2026**.

02. SUBMISSION OF COMPLETED APPLICATION FORMS

Students should handover their duly filled application forms to the Department from **9.00 a.m.** to **12.00 noon** and from **1.00 p.m.** to **4.00 p.m** on or before **20th July 2026**.

N. B. - Students' Record Books should be produced when applications are handedover.

03. FILLING IN THE APPLICATION FORMS

It is the responsibility of the candidates to enter all subjects (Title of Question Papers with Code Numbers) clearly in the application form. Heads of Departments may be consulted with regard to any clarification in completing the application forms.

04. APPLICATIONS FROM STUDENTS WHO HAVE FAILED OR HAVE NOT COMPLETED THEIR PREVIOUS EXAMINATIONS

Those students who fall into the above category are required to pay the appropriate examination fees along with their applications. The fees can be paid at any branch of the Bank of Ceylon, to the credit of the Sabaragamuwa University, Account Number **0002246976** at Bank of Ceylon, Balangoda Branch, or direct to the Shroff of the University. Receipts for payment of fees should be attached to the applications.
