The AHEAD Operation of the Sabaragamuwa University of Sri Lanka requests Expression of Interest from interested parties for the above mentioned consultancy, under the ELTA/ELSE Faculty Grant - Faculty of Applied Sciences.

1. BACKGROUND

The development of thehigher education sector is of central importance to enable Sri Lanka to make the transition from a Lower-Middle Income Country (LMIC) to an Upper Middle-Income Country (UMIC). Recognizing this, the Government of Sri Lanka (GoSL) and the World Bank have agreed, to support the higher education sector through a Bank Funded Accelerating Higher Education Expansion and Development (AHEAD) operation.

Faculty of Applied Sciences was established in 1996 with three academic departments and it currently consists of five such departments. During the past development stages the Faculty has taken steps to incorporate outcome based education and learner cantered teaching. In addition, regular curriculum revisions at five year intervals enables the Faculty to identify and incorporate emerging requirements in the industry and keep the curricular up to date, while we are dedicated to become a centre of excellence in education.

Under the program on Accelerating Higher Education Expansion and Development (AHEAD), we the Faculty of Applied Sciences have recognized following five activities as the most required activities to enhance academic excellence, socio-emotional skills and English language skills of our undergraduates;

Activity 1: Enriching Curricular, Learning and Teaching

Activity 2: Enriching Research and University-Industry linkage

Activity 3: Enriching Assessment Methods, Procedures and Examination process

Activity 4: Enriching English Learning Skills

Activity 5: Enriching Learner around Environment

Under the Activity 3 (Enriching Assessment Methods, Procedures and Examination process), it has been proposed to get an expert knowledge on how to hold mock interviews as part of a career fair for students.

2. THE OPERATION

Accelerating Higher Education Expansion and Development (AHEAD) operation is organized into two components. The first is a Program Component that supports the national Higher Education Development Program. The second is a systems strengthening, capacity building and technical assistance component that will assist GoSL to strengthen the higher education sector and achieve the objectives of the AHEAD program component. This second will also cover monitoring and evaluation, policy analyses, program coordination and communication.

The implementing agency is the Ministry of Higher Education, Technology and Innovations (MHETI). The University Grants Commission (UGC) coordinates the activities of the universities. There is an Operations Monitoring and Support Team (OMST) which coordinates and supports all AHEAD activities between the MHETH, UGC, and the universities.

AHEAD has three Results Areas:
