QUALIFICATIONS FOR VACANCIES

01. Works Superintendent Grade II

Qualifications : i.(a) National Diploma in Technology or equivalent qualifications and have at least four years experience in the relevant field after obtaining such qualifications.

Note : Period of in – plant training will not be counted for the four years' experience.

(b) National Certificate in Technology or equivalent qualifications and have at least ten years experience in the relevant field after obtaining such qualifications.

Age : Should be not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

Selection : By Interview

02. Pharmacist (Lower Grade)

Qualifications : Certificate of competence as a qualified pharmacist recognized by the Sri Lanka Medical Council.

03. Technical Officer Grade II Seg. 'B'

Qualifications : 1. (a) Three (03) G.C.E. (Advanced Level) Passes in Biological Science Stream or Physical Science Stream or Technology Streams in one sitting.

AND

(b) Passed a skill oriented formal programme of training relevant to the post of at least one year (full – time) duration or equivalent. The acceptability of the training programme for this purpose shall be judged by the faculty concerned.

Age : Not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

Selection : By Practical Test and an Interview

04. Supervisor (Civil) Grade III

Qualifications: 1. (a) National Certificate in Technology or equivalent qualifications with 3 years experience may be obtained while following the NCT course;

OR

(b) G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in Six (6) subjects at not more than two (2) Sittings with at least 5 years' experience as a supervisor in the relevant field in a government, local government or state corporation or a recognized engineering establishment.

Age : Not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

Selection : By Interview

05. Supervisor (Electrical) Grade III

Qualifications: 1. (a) National Certificate in Technology or equivalent qualifications with 3 years experience may be obtained while following the NCT course;

OR

(b) G.C.E. (Ordinary Level) Examination in Six (6) subjects at not more than two (2) Sittings with at least 5 years' experience as a supervisor in the relevant field in a government, local government or state corporation or a recognized engineering establishment.

Age : Not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

Selection : By Interview

06. Driver Grade III

Qualifications : Having Passed six (06) Subjects in G.C.E. (O/L) examination, at least with two (02) credit passes in maximum of two sittings.

AND

Having obtained the license issued by the Commissioner General of Motor Traffic for driving heavy vehicles and a minimum of three (03) years experience in driving after obtaining the driving license.

Note : Minimum Height 5ft. 2 ½ ins.
Must be physically fit for duty during day and night and must have a good eye sight.

Age : Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

Selection : By Trade Test and a Structured Interview

Salary Scale : UPL 3 (III)
Rs. 48,005 – 16 x 490 – 55,845/= (p.m.)

07. Technician Grade III

Qualifications : Having obtained a Proficiency Certificate not below than the National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) Level 4 issued by a Technical/ Vocational training institute accepted by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission, relevant to the function of each post.

(Preference will be given to candidates who possess sound knowledge of the aluminium industry, along with the ability to identify faults in refrigeration and air conditioning systems, water pumps, and electrical equipments, as well as an understanding of their repair and maintenance procedures.)

Age : Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

Selection : By Trade Test and a Structured Interview

Salary Scale : UPL 3 (III)
Rs. 48,005 – 16 x 490 – 55,845/= (p.m.)

08. Tractor Operator Grade III

Qualifications : 1. Should have passed the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six (06) subjects with at least two (02) credit passes in not more than two sittings and having obtained a proficiency certificate not below than the National Vocational Qualifications (NVQ) Level 2 or 3, issued by a Technical/ Vocational training institute accepted by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission, relevant to the function of each post. (A certificate of Equivalence issued by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission must be submitted to confirm the National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) Level for the course.)

OR

2. Should have passed the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six (06) subjects with at least two (02) credit passes in not more than two sittings and one (01) year working experience in a relevant field with industrial skills.

Note : Minimum Height 5ft. 2 ½ ins.
Must be physically fit for duty during day and night and must have a good eye sight.

Age : Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

Selection : By Trade Test and Structured Interview

Salary Scale : U-PL 2 (III)
Rs. 44,575 – 16 x 490 – 52,415/= (p.m.)

09. Laboratory Attendant Grade III

Qualifications : 1. Should have passed the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six (06) subjects with at least two (02) credit passes in not more than two sittings and having obtained a proficiency certificate not below than the National Vocational Qualifications (NVQ) Level 2 or 3, issued by a Technical/ Vocational training institute accepted by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission, relevant to the function of each post. (A certificate of Equivalence issued by the Tertiary and Vocational Education Commission must be submitted to confirm the National Vocational Qualification (NVQ) Level for the course.)

OR

2. Should have passed the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination in six (06) subjects with at least two (02) credit passes in not more than two sittings and one (01) year working experience in a relevant field with industrial skills.

Age : Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

Selection : By Trade Test and Structured Interview

Salary Scale : U-PL 2 (III)
Rs. 44,575 – 16 x 490 – 52,415/= (p.m.)

10. Health Service Labourer Grade III

Qualifications : Should have sat for the G.C.E. (O/L) Examination.

Age : Should be not less than 18 years and not more than 45 years of age on the closing date of applications.

Selection : By Trade Test and / or structured Interview

Salary Scale : UPL 1 (III)
Rs. 42,775 -16 x 450 – 49,975/= (p.m.)

Note : Every Applicant;

(iii) Should be of excellent moral character.

CONDITIONS OF SERVICE:

01. These posts are permanent. The appointments will be on probation for a period of three (03) years.
02. Selected candidates if presently serving in a Government Department will have to obtain his/ her release through their respective appointing authority.
03. Government employees will not be entitled to maintain their pension rights whilst in the University Service.

BENEFITS

01. Selected candidates will begin to contribute to the Universities Provident Fund by means of monthly deductions from his/ her salary and amount equal to ten percent (10%) of his/ her basic salary. The University will, in addition out of its funds contribute at the same time a sum equal to seven percent (07%) of his/ her earnings to the Universities Provident Fund and eight percent (08%) of his/ her earnings to the Pension Fund.
02. Three (03%) per centum of his/ her basic salary will be contributed by the University to the Employees Trust Fund in terms of Provision of the Employees Trust Fund.
